Entry corrections get a payment gate on August 5

CBP has modified its Post-Summary Correction (PSC) test. From **August 5, 2026**, the mechanics of fixing an entry change for every ACE filer — importers of record, customs brokers, self-filers, and the compliance teams behind them.

THE THREE CHANGES THAT MATTER

01

ACH-only payment

Any increase in duties, taxes, or fees resulting from a PSC must be paid via ACH Debit or ACH Credit. Checks and cash are out.

02

Full-payment gate

A new PSC cannot be filed on an entry until the prior PSC's increase is paid in full and processed. A partial payment blocks the next fix.

03

Suspended-liquidation path formalized

PSCs beyond the 300-day window are allowed where liquidation is suspended with an ACE suspension basis (AD/CVD, EAPA, court injunction).

OPERATOR IMPACT

Importers without ACH enrollment, or with slow internal payment approval, can lose the ability to file a correction exactly when they need one. Brokers inherit a client-discipline problem: one unpaid or partially paid increase blocks the next correction on that entry.

FINE POINTS WORTH KNOWING

- You may pay a PSC increase before liquidation or wait for the bill at liquidation — but the full-payment gate applies either way. Document who makes that call.
- Interest is not accepted before liquidation; it is assessed and billed at liquidation.
- ACH enrollment questions go to ACH-Customs@cbp.dhs.gov. Enrollment is the gate to correcting your own entries after August 5.

FILLABLE WORKSHEET

Correction Readiness Review

Work through this with your broker or entry team **before August 5, 2026**. Assign an owner and a date to each step.

- Inventory open corrections.** Pull open entries and PSC history from ACE or your broker's reports; list any PSC increases not yet paid in full.

- Confirm ACH enrollment.** Verify ACH Debit or ACH Credit is active. If missing, start enrollment now (ACH-Customs@cbp.dhs.gov).

Owner _____ Target date _____

- Set your payment default.** Decide: pay PSC increases before liquidation, or wait for the bill — and document who makes that call per entry type.

Owner _____ Target date _____

- Ban partial payments.** Set one hard control: no partial payments on PSC increases. A partial payment blocks the next correction on that entry.

Owner _____ Target date _____

- Map filing responsibility.** Identify who files PSCs on each lane — broker or self-filed — and align procedures with the August 5 rules on both sides.

Owner _____ Target date _____

- Push data quality upstream.** Classification, valuation, and origin errors are what force corrections in the first place — and corrections are getting more procedural.

Deadlines and effective dates for import operations, July–September 2026. Calendar the ones that touch your lanes and assign an owner.

NOW IN EFFECT

June 29, 2026 Morocco phosphate emergency duty-free window running (about eight months, into late February 2027), including a CVD cash-deposit waiver.

July 1, 2026 CBP entry-data information-collection revisions published; comment dockets open (Entry Summary; Entry/Immediate Delivery + ACE Cargo Release; Cargo Manifest/ISF).
